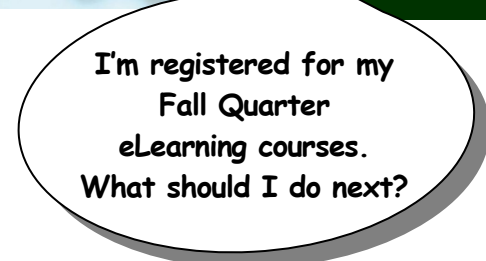

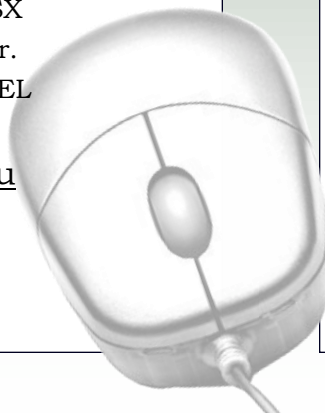
1. I have access to a computer 5-7 days, per week.

5. I know how to open, save, and manage computer files.

7. I have 12 to 20 hours a week to work on each class.

IMPORTANT: Print, Read & Follow these 7 Steps for Academic Success!

1. **Course Listings** <http://online.southseattle.edu/distance/list.asp>
Click your course item # to find Instructor E-mail, Type Of Course (Platform), Section .78 Course Dates, Website address, etc.
2. **E-mail Your Instructor** for "How to Get Started" steps (see #1)
~ Some courses require in-person meetings and proctored testing
~ WAOL courses (.78) – Instructor info becomes available upon first login
3. **LOGIN to Your Course** –All classes open 1st day of QTR, except for Angel:
 - ✓ **ANGEL** – <http://angel.southseattle.edu>
Opens a week before QTR begins
[WARNING: Section .78's run on different dates, usually earlier, see #1]
Username = your Student ID number [SID], (i.e., 98XXXXXXX)
Password = first 5 letters of lastname [lowercase, no spaces, hyphens]
 - ✓ **Online Math** – <http://mathonline.southseattle.edu>
E-mail your instructor for mathonline "login" information
 - ✓ **SSCC Web Apps** – <http://students.southseattle.edu>
Find faculty (course/portal) web address (see #1)
Username = 1st letter of first name + whole last name +
last 3 digits of Student Identification Number (SID)
Password = Same as Username, until you change it upon first login
 - ✓ **Telecourse** – E-mail instructor (see #1)
